Southern Wiltshire Neighbourhood Policing Team Alderbury & Laverstock beat local crime reports.

April 2016

The list below provides a summary of recent local crimes from **1st to 31st March 2016**. It is not possible to list all the crimes due to confidentiality issues (e.g. if the crime was violent or for domestic disputes). Please find below a selection of the 79 incidents reported to Police in our beat this month. There are 38 reported crimes this month with 41 non crime reports. A slight increase in crime reports from last month, although overall incidents reported were down.

OLD SARUM	4 th – Criminal damage – Unknown suspect has set fire to child's quad bike. 14 th – Burglary – 2 x Warehouse's had windows forced. Cash stolen. 31 st – Criminal damage – Unknown suspect has damaged steel front door.
PITTON	<i>No reported incidents</i>
WEST DEAN	13 th – Burglary – Barn door forced – Wood burner and tools stolen. 17 th – Criminal damage – positioned nail punctured car tyre.
WHITEPARISH	1 st – Illegal immigrant – Person located in rear of lorry, arrested. 2 nd – Theft – 2x ferrets stolen from rear garden. 7 th – Theft – Bird scarer with battery and charger stolen from field
WINTERSLOW	1 st – Theft – 400 chickens stolen from chicken farm. 3 rd – Theft – Heating oil stolen from tank in front garden. 10 th – Burglary attempt – Damage to rear of warehouse.
