The list below provides a summary of recent local crimes from **1st to 31st May 2016**. FORD	11 th - Burglary attempt – padlock prised off warehouse door. Nothing taken.
GRIMSTEADS	<i>No reported incidents</i>
LANDFORD	9 th - Theft – entry gained to compound, diesel stolen from tank. 12 th - Burglary attempt – access gained to garages. Nothing taken. 15 th - Theft – tools and mobile phone taken from unattended vehicle.
LAVERSTOCK	5 th - ASB – egg cracked on unattended vehicle. 17 th - Burglary attempt – back door forced. Nothing taken. 18 th - Burglary attempt - attempt to force window and door unsuccessfully. Nothing taken.
OLD SARUM	22 nd - Burglary attempt – suspect interrupted whilst damaging garage door to gain access. Nothing taken. 24 th - Criminal Damage – bike shelter damaged. 30 th - Criminal Damage – unknown item thrown at window causing it to shatter.
