Southern Wiltshire Neighbourhood Policing Team Alderbury & Laverstock beat local crime reports.

November 2014

The list below provides a summary of recent local crimes from **1st to 31st October 2014**. It is not possible to list all the crimes due to confidentiality issues (e.g. if the crime was violent or for domestic disputes). Please find below a selection of the 64 incidents reported to Police in our beat this month. Only 31 reported crimes this month with 33 non crime reports, this is a rise from last month in both sectors.

ALDERBURY	04/10 - Traffic related - Following collision driver arrested over the limit. 11/10 - Criminal Damage - Attempt to enter vehicle, damage to door handle.

OLD SARUM	01/10 - Criminal Damage - Vehicle door forced, nothing stolen from within.

WEST DEAN	31/10 - Theft - Vehicle window forced and handbag stolen from within.
WHITEPARISH	04/10 - Criminal Damage - Plant pot smashed on gatepost. 05/10 - Theft - Small pieces of scaffolding stolen from side of house. 06/10 - Theft - Ornamental stones taken from front garden. 13/10 - Burglary - Garden tools stolen from garage. 22/10 - Theft - Construction equipment stolen from secure container on site.
WINTERSLOW	21/10 - Theft - Horse blanket stolen from horse in field.
