The list below provides a summary of recent local crimes from 1st to 30th November 2014. It is not possible to list all the crimes due to confidentiality issues (e.g. if the crime was violent or for domestic disputes). Please find below a selection of the 66 incidents reported to Police in our beat this month. Only 30 reported crimes this month with 36 non crime reports, this is a small rise from last month.

ALDERBURY	09/11 – Damage – Damage to fence panel 16/11 – Theft – Vehicle window smashed and chainsaws removed from rear of vehicle.

LAVERSTOCK	07/11 – Theft – Secure bicycle stolen from bike rack 11/11 – Damage – Bicycle damaged whilst on bike rack
OLD SARUM	11/11 – Damage – Chain link fencing cut. 23/11 – Traffic related – Suspect arrested for drink driving.
PITTON	02/11 - Drugs – Suspect located with small amount of cannabis.
WEST DEAN	<i>No reported incidents</i>
WHITEPARISH	07/11 – Theft – 2x pairs of wellies stolen from porchway. 07/11 – Theft – Red diesel siphoned from tank approx. 800 galls.
WINTERSLOW	06/11 – Damage – 'X' scratched onto wooden door. 06/11 – Theft – Vehicle window smashed and handbag stolen from within. 13/11 – Traffic related – Suspect arrested for drink driving. 17/11 – Theft – Handbag stolen from vehicle. 19/11 – Theft – Loose change taken from insecure vehicle 22/11 – Theft – Vehicle window smashed and bag containing laptop stolen.
