

**Approved minutes of an Extraordinary meeting of Alderbury Parish Council held on
Wednesday 1st August 2018 at St. Marys Hall, Whaddon.**

Present: Cllrs Hartford (Chairman), Fuller, Considine, Lawrence and Sloan.

In attendance: Unitary Cllr Britton, 2 members of the public.

Apologies: Cllrs Mernagh, Clarke, Diprose, Pace and Hughes.

Cllr Hartford opened the meeting at 8.00pm. She confirmed that the meeting would be recorded in the absence of the clerk.

5269. Apologies for absence and to consider whether to approve the reasons given.

Prior to the meeting apologies had been received from Cllrs Clarke, Hughes and Pace due to work commitments and Cllrs Diprose and Mernagh due to holiday commitments. Alderbury Parish Council resolved to approve the absences for the reasons given. The parish clerk, Alison McGowan, had also given her apologies as she was away on annual leave.

5270. Declaration of Cllrs Interests and dispensations

Cllr Sloan declared a personal interest in agenda item 5274.

Planning To respond to Wiltshire Council on the following planning applications:

5271. 18/06011/FUL – Firs End, Firs Road, Alderbury, Salisbury, SP5 3BD – Retrospective application for conversion of games room above garage/store to habitable accommodation for letting purposes.

Alderbury Parish Council considered this retrospective planning application. Mr Amor, the agent, commented that it complied with building regulations and is currently let to a family. Councillors drew attention to the original planning application 16/04989/FUL which only made provision for an upstairs games room and was passed by Wiltshire Council on 5th August 2016 subject to express conditions limiting the use.

Alderbury Parish Council resolved to 'object' to the application (with four objections and one abstention), citing impact on neighbours, parking and over development.

5272. 18/05902/FUL – Rivendell, 12 Clarendon Road, Alderbury, SP5 3AS – Timber potting and storage shed.

Alderbury Parish Council resolved to respond to the application with 'no comment' (four responses no comment and one no objection).

The chairman moved agenda item 5274 forward as residents were in attendance to discuss the application and answer any questions.

5274. 18/06809/FUL – 23 Eyres Drive, Alderbury, Wiltshire, SP5 3TD – Proposed rear flat roof extension.

Alderbury Parish Council resolved to 'support' the planning application.

5273. 18/05195/CLE – Nightwood Farm, Lucewood Lane, West Grimstead -Certificate of Lawfulness for existing bund.

This application relating to the method of dealing with asbestos waste, had been submitted on the basis that the owner did not need planning permission to cover the asbestos with a grass bund.

Alderbury Parish Council resolved to maintain its objection to the presence of asbestos and reiterate the need to remove it as it is currently unlawful. A copy of the Parish Council's objections would be sent to the Head of Development at Wiltshire Council.
