Parish Cemetery Footpath Repairs

This footpath is used daily by visitors to the cemetery and walkers. The path also has to provide entry into the cemetery for the grass cutting machine and the grave digger.

The path is now in a poor state and unusable during periods of heavy rain, resulting in further erosion occurring beyond the edges of the current path. Loose gravel was put down about four years ago but this has now all sunk into the mud. A more long-lasting solution is now needed as follows:

- Scrape back mud from current path (12 metres length) and the entrance area to the gate into the cemetery
- Replace wooden edging (current edging broken and sunk)
- Put down a hard core base
- Cover with top surface of firm ('sticky') gravel
