Terms and Conditions

Deed of Grant

Once your application has been considered, a Deed of the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial will be sent to you. The Deed is for a period of fifty years. There is a fee. Interment can only be in a grave purchased in this way.

You will need to apply to have the rights transferred to anyone not on the original document. This may incur a fee.

General

In being granted the Exclusive Right of Burial, we hereby agree to abide by the Burial Ground Regulations.

Memorials

Permission must be obtained from the Council prior to a memorial being fixed. A fee is payable. You will need to hold the Deed of Grant.

Please be aware that no form of memorial, other than that prescribed under the Council's Burial Ground Regulations will be allowed to be placed on the purchased grave.
