

Primary School Drain Art Project

The village primary school is hoping to become part of a project being organised by DEED – a learning and education centre (serving South Wiltshire, Dorset and Hampshire) that supports education and innovation by encouraging and inspiring teachers, pupils and community members to develop their understanding of global issues.

Drain Art

The project is about exploring the impact of litter on our local and global environment.

Pupils come up with ideas and 'drain art' designs. With the help of an artist, a final design will be installed around a drain in the school/pre-school car park. Throughout the project the focus will be on raising awareness about our interconnection with the ocean - what happens when we drop litter on the streets, which can get washed down the drain, into the rivers and out to sea. Ocean plastic pollution is one of many environmental problems we are facing, and small actions like Drain Art really help our young people to be part of a more positive future.
