Just some comments for consideration at the next PC meeting on 8th August from some of the residents bordering the area.

First, re the previous meeting although we are opposing the planting of willow trees in the area we would like to commend your environment team with regard to the wildflower and hedge planting they have done in the area. There is no doubt that we have seen many more butterflies in our gardens as a result of this and as the hedges grow perhaps small birds will return also.

Secondly re the referral of the red ash tree pollarding to WC we would like to point out that amongst the trees very severely pollarded by Messrs Treemenders in the past, one was a willow in the garden fence junction of numbers 12 and 14 Oakwood Grove. This is very close to the red ash and is struggling to survive and is exhibiting a large amount of fungus on its little remaining trunk (as did the nearby large oak before the successful and ongoing treatment to it). It is not on the TPO list but any tree is worth saving although it is extremely close to number 14 and hence needs to be kept under control.
