Results of Traffic Surveys

The detailed results are available if anyone wants to see them. Here I just summarise the criteria and the results.

The traffic survey will record 85th percentile speed for each vehicle and this will be used to determine if the site enters the thresholds for intervention and detailed as follows;

<i>Speed Limit (MPH)</i>	<i>No further action (85%ile)</i>	<i>Considered for Community Speed Watch (85%ile)</i>	<i>Police Enforcement (85%ile)</i>
<i>20mph</i>	<i>20 mph to 24 mph</i>	<i>24.1 mph to 38.9 mph</i>	<i>Over 39 mph</i>
<i>30mph</i>	<i>30 mph to 35 mph</i>	<i>35.1 mph to 41.9 mph</i>	<i>Over 42 mph</i>
<i>40mph</i>	<i>40 mph to 46 mph</i>	<i>46.1 mph to 49.9 mph</i>	<i>Over 50 mph</i>

Further to your traffic survey request for the C321 Clarendon Road in Alderbury, please find attached the results for your records along with details of the criteria that we follow for intervention.

*The survey results demonstrate that the combined 85%ile was **36.9 mph.***

Email for Southampton Road

Further to your traffic survey request for the C234 Southampton Road in Alderbury, please find attached the results for your records along with details of the criteria that we follow for intervention.

*The survey results demonstrate that the combined 85%ile was **33.1 mph.***

Where sites do not meet the eligibility criteria for Community Speed Watch, there may be other engineering solutions which can help mitigate against concerns or further reinforce the current speed limit. If there is a desire to consider this, you are encouraged to discuss with your local Town and Parish Council in the first instance, ahead of seeking advice from the Local Highway Footway Improvement Group (LHFIG).
