Good morning Alderbury Parish Council,

It has come to our attention that the below areas currently mapped for Wiltshire Council grounds maintenance have been mapped in error and the land is actually owned by Alderbury Parish Council, see Land Registry information attached.

Green = Grass / **Yellow** = Hedge



I am therefore emailing you to advise that Wiltshire Council will be removing these areas from our grounds maintenance schedules.

In order to allow Alderbury Parish Council time to inspect the areas and put in place your own maintenance arrangements we will continue to cut until the end of this grass cutting season, October 2024.

We have noted the comments in The Fountain re the work on the oak tree in the Amenities Area, Oakwood Grove, and think that the tree company the PC employed to reshape the tree and preserve it have done an excellent job. The oak looks really healthy and has no fungus projecting from it.

Perhaps you would consider to put on your list of tree work in the village to have the red ash tree, adjacent to the above oak tree, reshaped in the autumn as it has grown rapidly and is particularly overhanging our neighbour's house, No 12 Oakwood Grove, and our garage.
