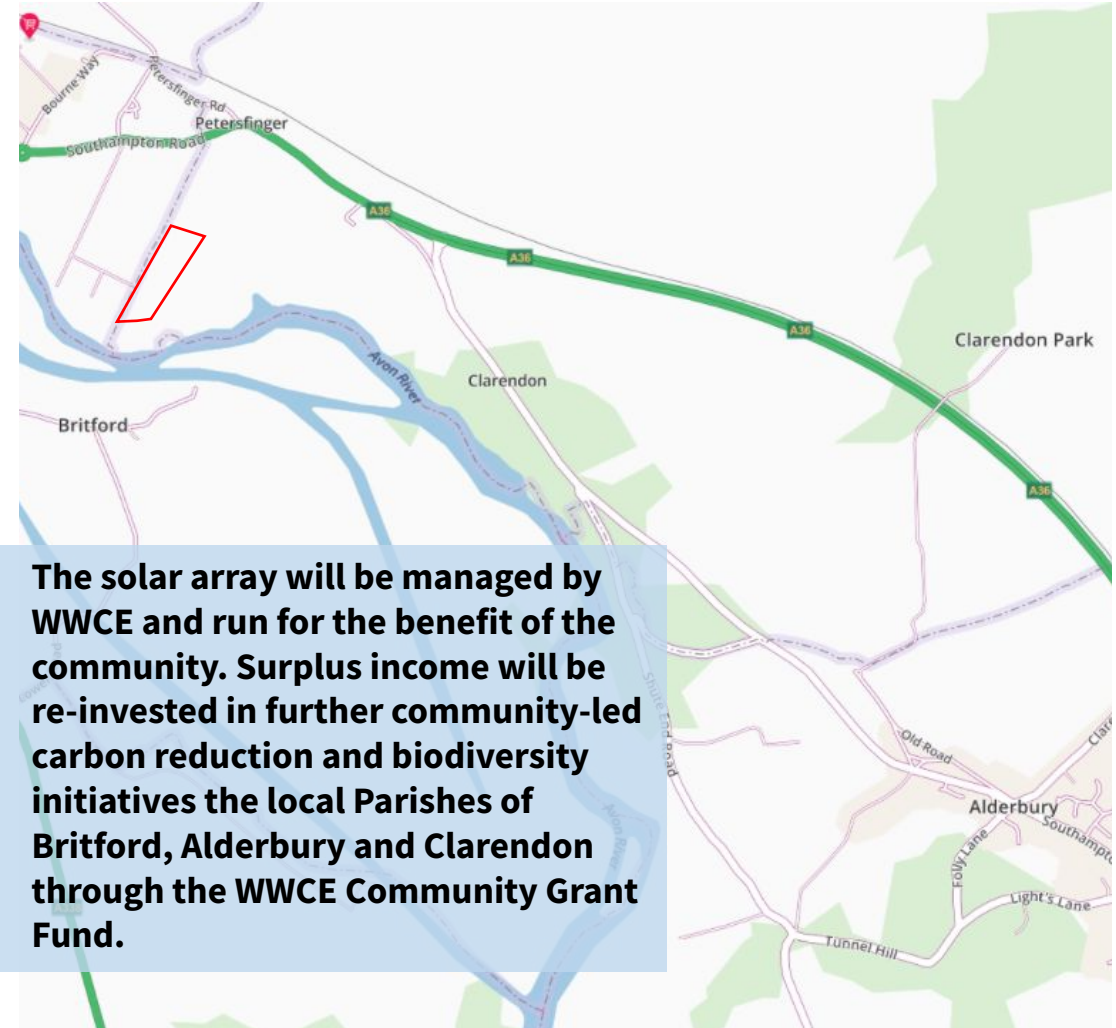

Petersfinger Community Solar array

Wiltshire Wildlife **Community Energy**

We are conducting a feasibility study for a 2MW, 7 acre solar community owned solar array in Petersfinger, Salisbury.

The array would generate over 2,000 MWh, equivalent to around 730 average UK homes, and reducing over 500 tonnes of CO₂ per year.



The solar array will be managed by WWCE and run for the benefit of the community. Surplus income will be re-invested in further community-led carbon reduction and biodiversity initiatives the local Parishes of Britford, Alderbury and Clarendon through the WWCE Community Grant Fund.

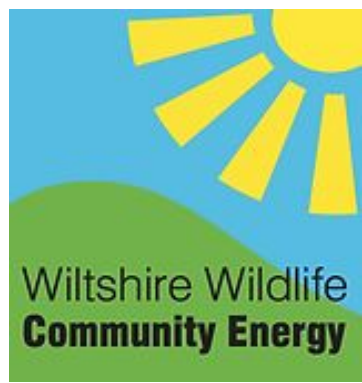
Next steps:

- Feasibility work underway, to complete in January 2022, including:
 - Connection to the electricity network and sewage treatment works
 - Flood risk, ecology, visual impact and other planning considerations
 - Financial viability
- Meetings with Britford, Alderbury and Clarendon parish councils December and January
- Webpage now live – we will keep it updated
- Please encourage people to complete our online survey
- If the findings of the feasibility work and initial community discussions are positive:
 - Planning application to be submitted in 2022
 - If successful, construction from 2023
