
## **Petersfinger Community Solar array**

We are conducting a feasibility study for a 2MW, 7 acre solar community owned solar array in Petersfinger, Salisbury.

The array would generate over 2,000 MWh, equivalent to around 730 average UK homes, and reducing over 500 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> per year.

#### **Next steps:**


- Feasibility work underway, to complete in January 2022, including:
