6107. Queen's Platinum Jubilee

With the Jubilee fast approaching, to consider how the Parish Council wishes to commemorate the occasion. A 'Picnic in the Park' event is again planned and this is pencilled-in for Saturday 11th June 2022. Other Parish Councils are joining in the celebrations by taking part in <a href="the national beacon celebration">the national beacon celebration</a>. The recommended approach would be to commission a permanent beacon to be built by local crafts persons – blacksmith, carpenter, builder, etc. The Royal Family have issued <a href="plans and guidance on how to create a beacon">plans and guidance on how to create a beacon</a>. This could be located on the village green or perhaps on a high point within the parish (the idea is that they can be seen from a long distance). Once erected, the beacon could be used for local and national celebrations for decades to come. The costs will have to be met from reserves in accordance with the budget policy. A decision in principle is required in order that quotes may be sought and submitted for approval.
