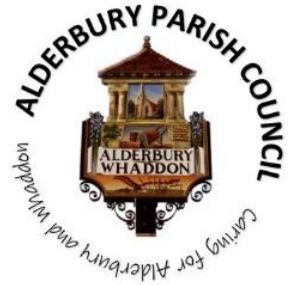


**DRAFT Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of Alderbury Parish Council  
held on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2023

**Public question time**

- Residents all expressed their disappointment that the application has been resubmitted with so few changes addressing the reasons for rejection last time. Neither does there appear to be any attempt to explain how they think they are addressing the objections. Main points raised:
  - Density
  - Traffic
  - The environmental impact
  - Inadequate drainage
  - Outside the settlement boundary

- How this would change the nature of the village through density and biodiversity loss
